

## **THE FINCHLEY SOCIETY ENVIRONMENT & TRANSPORT COMMITTEE**

### Objects

Within the areas of the former Borough of Finchley and the former Urban District of Friern Barnet:

- a) To promote high standards in the environment, including recycling, pollution, graffiti, litter, and the care, wellbeing and preservation of trees, open spaces, hedges and water courses.
- b) To carry out surveys of specific aspects of the environment and take appropriate consequential action.
- c) To preserve and stimulate interest in local wildlife and wildlife habitats.
- d) To encourage the relevant authorities to provide a high standard of roads, of road maintenance, of local transport and of the environment which meets the present and future needs of the public.
- e) To monitor the impact of local transport on the environment and on the public, including traffic circulation, parking and the convenience of the services for the public.
- f) To preserve, protect, develop and improve features of historic or public interest.
- g) To conduct reviews and surveys.
- h) To publish reports.
- i) To promote in schools and youth groups, education in environmental matters and their awareness of the importance of the environment.
