

PHOTOGRAPHIC COMPETITION 2018 - 2020

The Finchley Society has organised a competition to encourage its members to share their photographs of Finchley and Friern Barnet. The objective of the competition is to encourage members to look around them and record something of interest and to share the image with others.

Members of the Society and their immediate family can submit photographs to the competition. Photographs should portray Finchley and Friern Barnet throughout the four seasons. Submissions will be judged every second month and the winning photograph will be published in the Newsletter and may be used to produce a calendar. At the end of the two years the best photograph will be chosen from among the twelve bi-monthly winners and awarded a £50 prize.

RULES

1. The subject of the photo should portray the Finchley and Friern Barnet area throughout the four seasons.
2. The competition is open to Finchley Society members and members of their immediate family.
3. Entries should be landscape format, high resolution digital files although hard copy (minimum 6" x 8") will be accepted.
4. Photos may be digitally enhanced to remove spots and scratches but not otherwise altered in any manner.
5. Each entry to be identified by location, name, address and phone number.
6. Entries to be emailed to photos@finchleysociety.org.uk with a subject line of *Photographic competition*.
7. Closing date, 1st of each of the months – January, March, May, July, September, November as applicable.
8. Although entrants retain the copyright to the image, the entry becomes the property of The Finchley Society to use at its discretion and may be published in the Newsletter and on the website.
9. The entries shall be judged by a minimum of three people selected by the Administration Committee and their decision shall be final.
10. No relatives of the judges shall be permitted to enter the competition.
11. All works shall be original and not copies from other sources. Entrants having any identifiable person under the age of 16 in the photo must have signed parental consent.
12. Entries shall not have been used in other competitions.
13. Entrants must agree to these rules. If broken the organisers have the right to refuse entry.
14. The Finchley Society reserves the right to cancel the competition due to circumstances outside its control.
15. The best of the 12 entries will be adjudged the overall winner and will be awarded the prize of £50.
16. Should the overall winner not be contactable after reasonable attempts, the organisers have the right to offer the prize to the runner-up.
17. Names of competition winners will be published in each Newsletter and a full list published at the end of the competition.
